11. Château Les Miaudoux, BERGERAC ROSÉ, France 🍷 13% <i>Produced from organically grown Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, this is very pretty, crisp and dry rosé with a pronounced white currant aroma and flavour, supported by a hint of nettle and elderflower.</i>			15.50
12. Margan SHIRAZ SAIGNÉE, Hunter Valley, Australia 🍷 13.5% <i>Packed with spicy pepper and strawberry fruit and perfect for chilling, this is a pretty serious and structured rosé.</i>			19.50

13. Freedom Cross CINSAULT/CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Coastal Region, South Africa 14% <i>Lots of bright summer berry fruit flavours and aromas here, hints of fruit jelly and a dash of pepper, really soft and juicy in the mouth and not bad chilled either!</i>			14.00
14. Rayun CARMENÈRE, Rapel Valley, Chile 13% <i>Gorgeous, rich black fruits with a touch of vanilla, tobacco and even honey, this is a dry red but with a lovely, very ripe fruit flavour, good texture and long length.</i>			14.50
15. Vicuña CABERNET SAUVIGNON/MERLOT, Central Valley, Chile 12.5% <i>Medium bodied, soft and supple with pretty blackberry fruit, hints of crushed flowers, sweet spice and a touch of toasty oak.</i>	3.00	4.25	12.50
16. Stellar Organics 'Running Duck', SHIRAZ, Western Cape, South Africa 🍷 13.5% <i>A deliciously sappy Shiraz, with good spicy black fruit flavours and a hint of white pepper, medium bodied and really easy drinking, it also ticks the boxes of being Organic and Fairtrade</i>			15.50
17. Rioja Vega TINTO CRIANZA, Rioja, Spain 13.5% <i>The winery at Rioja Vega was overhauled in 2001 and their wines have surged forward. From Tempranillo with a little Mazuelo and Garnacha, this is really very elegant, with a delicate creamy vanilla core, rich red and black fruit flavours and a sprinkling of wild herbs.</i>			17.50
18. Maiden Flight Reserva PINOT NOIR, Casablanca Valley, Chile 14% <i>Very pretty sweet red and black fruits supported on the juicy, medium-bodied palate by a hint of mocha. Great freshness, ripe tannins and long lasting flavours.</i>			17.50
19. Don Cristobal 1492 MALBEC, Mendoza, Argentina 14% <i>A perfect combination of ripe red fruit character and spice, enhanced by subtle use of French oak barrels. The palate is rich, beefy and almost savoury with lovely length</i>			16.50

20. Tanners CAVA BRUT, Spain 11.5% <i>Softly textured, with lots of mouth-watering lemon and lime citrus fruit flavours ahead of a typically toasty finish. Produced by Conde de Caralt, a separately managed part of the Freixenet group.</i>			16.50
21. Castell d'Olèrdola CAVA BRUT ROSADO, Spain 11.5% <i>Delicious summer fruit aromas and flavours of strawberries and raspberries, with a delicate floral note and a dry finish. Produced by the quality minded house of Olivella Ferrari.</i>			17.50
22. BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE Brut NV, France 12% <i>A powerful yet elegant Pinot Noir-based champagne, with a pronounced brioche character on the nose and flavours of citrus, nuts, figs and spice on the palate.</i>			45.00
